of the island, the

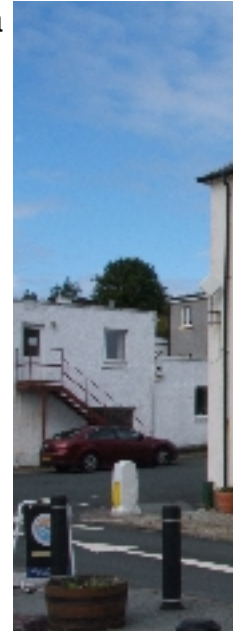
